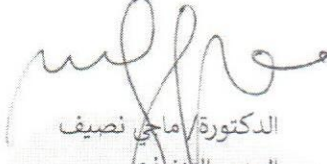

AY2027-2028 Fulbright Egyptian Scholar Program Research Grant

The Fulbright Egyptian Scholar Program –Research Grant provides opportunities for Egyptian faculty members from Egyptian universities and research centers to conduct research at U.S. institutions in all fields of study.

Grant Duration:

3 to 9 months.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Egyptian citizenship.
- Applicants must be residing in Egypt starting from the application process and throughout the selection, placement and pre-departure processes.
- Full time faculty member at a university in Egypt, or a full-time research member at an Egyptian research center.
- Ph.D. degree is required.
- Excellent command of English.
- Applicants have to successfully complete all the steps of the application, assessment, and selection process and successfully finalize all required procedures.
- The following persons and their immediate family members (i.e. spouses and children) are ineligible to apply during and for a period ending one year following the termination of such employment: employees of the U.S. Department of State; local employees of the U.S. missions abroad who work for the U.S. Department of State; employees at organizations implementing exchange programs for the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs at the Department of State; as well as Board Members or staff of a Fulbright Commission or their families (up to fourth kin).
- U.S. citizens and green card holders and applicants are not eligible to apply.

Note:

- *Preference will be given to applicants without prior significant experience in the U.S. and/or overseas.*
- *Applicants in all fields of study: the humanities, social sciences, arts, the sciences and STEM fields, as well as the medical and health fields can apply to the Fulbright Egyptian Student Program. Applicants in the fields of medicine, veterinary medicine, nursing, psychological counseling, and dentistry should be aware that their programs cannot include clinical studies or direct contact with patients.*

Required Documents: (All documents must be uploaded to the online application by no later than October 10, 2026. Please carefully read the Application Instructions accessible via the link provided below)

- Ph.D. certificate in English
- CV with clear contact information and updated publications
- Letter of support from home institution
- Three recommendation letters
- Scanned copy of the original valid National ID
- Personal photo
- Scanned copies of any previous U.S. J1 or J2 visas (if applicable)

Important: The Fulbright Program seeks applicants that have developed a sense of personal integrity and are original thinkers. Copying someone else's writing, whether from the Internet, from a book or from a friend is considered plagiarism. Any quoted words or sentences should include a citation. Use of AI tools in any part of the Fulbright application must also be clearly disclosed. An applicant who is found to have plagiarized in any form (including unintentional or accidental plagiarism), or to have used AI tools to replace his or her original thoughts or without proper disclosure in his or her application will be disqualified.
